RULES:

- Two people per boat.
- Boat inspection 6:00am to 8:00am
- Fishing hours 8:00am to 4:15pm. According to light time.
- Trickle start 2 flights: 8:00am, 8:15am.
- Total live release tournament.
- Each team will be allowed to weigh up to 4 fish per day.
- A full Manitoba Licence is required.
- All Sauger, Saugeye, and Pickerel are eligible to be weighed in.
- Any dead or stressed fish brought in will not be counted.
- All boats must be equipped with live wells or coolers with aerators.
- No passing of items between boats during fishing hours.
- No fisherman will be allowed to go a shore, except at the fishing dock.
- Boats must stay 5 ft. Apart during fishing hours.
- And 5ft. Apart around the dock.
- Boat inspections will be done during fishing hours.
- No boats coming in late will be allowed fish weigh-in.
- The fish tails will be pinched when measured.
- All Manitoba fishing regulations apply
- Only 2 walleye over (28 in.) Per boat for weekend.
- Only 2 walleye between (22 in. & 28 in.) Per boat, in possession at one time.
- All walleye under (22 in.) Count.

Judges decisions will be final.
